RESPONSIBILITY – Catawese Coach Lines, Inc acts solely in the capacity of an agent on behalf of its tour patrons and as such, arranges for transportation, lodging, admissions, sightseeing, and other services. We are not responsible for any damage, loss, delay, injury or accident due to any act or default on the part of any company or person engaged in providing transportation, lodging, admissions, sightseeing or other services which are part of the tour. Rates quoted in this brochure are based on current tariffs at the time of printing and, although we anticipate no change, rates are subject to change at or before time of final payment. Catawese Coach Lines, Inc reserves the right to withdraw or make changes in any tour that may become necessary in such a case.

RESERVATIONS – When making a reservation, the following information will be required: your name, address, day time phone, home phone, desired pick up location and names of everyone in your party.

SEATING – With our computerized reservation system, you may request where in the coach you would like to be seated, window or aisle, front, middle or rear. By making reservations early, you'll be assured of sitting together and in the area of the coach you prefer.

SMOKING – Due to federal regulations, smoking is not permitted on any tour. We apologize for any inconvenience this may pose and we will make efforts to include stops en route to your destination.

DEPARTURE POINTS – All tours depart from our office on Trevorton Road, as well as Shamokin, Kulpmont, Mount Carmel, Shamokin Dam, Danville and Bloomsburg Parking personal vehicles at pick up locations is done at your own risk and not a responsibility of Catawese Coach Lines, Inc. or the property owner.

PAYMENT POLICIES –

One-Day tours - \$10 per person or ticket cost per person. Deposit required two weeks from date of reservation with balance due two weeks prior to trip date.

Overnight tours - \$50 per person or ticket cost per person. Deposit required two weeks from date of reservation with balance due one month prior to trip date.

Vacation tours - \$100 per person. Deposit required two weeks from date of reservation with balance due one month prior to trip date.

Please note: If no payment is received within the above-described time frame, we reserve the right to cancel your reservation without notification. When paying through the mail with check or money order, please be sure to specify the tour, date and names of all passengers in your group.

CANCELLATIONS – Payments received for one day tours will be refunded if notice is received in our office two weeks prior to the trip date, provided no advance purchase tickets were involved. A 25% cancellation fee will be charged if notice is received less than 14 days prior to trip date. No refunds for cancellations made 3 days prior to trip date. There will be no refunds for pre-purchased tickets such as sporting events and Radio City Music Hall Christmas Spectacular. If you must cancel on such a tour, our office will attempt to resell the tickets for you, but cannot guarantee our success in doing so. Overnight and vacation tours are subject to cancellation fees if cancelled less than one month prior to departure and are based on supplier policies.

LUGGAGE – One piece of luggage per person is permitted for vacation tours. A carryon is permissible if handled personally by the passenger. Although we take the utmost care in handling luggage, we cannot assume responsibility for loss or damage. Luggage tags will be issued for one piece of luggage and we ask they remain on the luggage for the duration of the trip. Due to security, we reserve the right to inspect or refuse any luggage without prior notification.

INCLEMENT WEATHER – No matter the time of year, weather can play an integral part of tour plans. During winter months, all tours will depart as scheduled unless otherwise recommended or prohibited by the State Police or Governor. In Spring/Summer, all tours will depart as scheduled, rain or shine, unless a supplier notifies us of an event cancellation. Catawese Coach is not responsible for lack of notification on the part of the supplier prior to our scheduled departure. We reserve the right to alter an itinerary based on weather conditions.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES - Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the passenger area of the coach on any of our tours. Coolers may be placed in the luggage compartment for later consumption.

OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS – We reserve the right for our employees to remove, from a tour, any person acting in an abusive or disruptive manner. Any passenger(s) posing a safety hazard to other passengers or to the tour will be left in a public area with access to phone and shelter. These passengers will not be eligible for any type of refund.

ESCORTS – Escorts are company personnel provided to assist in the comfort and enjoyment of passengers while on board the coach. They are not "tour guides". Responsibilities include assisting the driver, attending to passenger needs and handling of tickets and paperwork as required. The blooming of the cherry trees around the Jefferson Memorial in Washington, D.C. has come to symbolize the natural beauty of our nation's capital city. Hundreds of thousands of city residents and visitors from across the nation and around the world come here to witness the spectacle, hoping that the trees will be at the peak of bloom, Washington, D.C.'s rite of spring. The year 2009 marks the 97th celebration of the original gift of 3,000 cherry trees from the city of Tokyo. Washington's historic monuments are framed in springtime splendor when the Japanese cherry trees bloom. The famous trees indicate the coming of Spring with an explosion of life and color surrounding the monuments on the Tidal Basin in a sea of pink and white. After a brief driving tour of the area (traffic patterns permitting), the day is yours to do as you please.

*The Peak Bloom Date is defined as the day in which 70% of the blossoms open. The date when the blossoms reach peak bloom varies from year to year, depends on weather conditions. Cherry Blossom dates are set based on the average date of blooming which is April 5th, but nature is not always cooperative". For these reasons we cannot guarantee blooms will be in full bloom but we do have reasonable expectations they will be when we visit.

SPRINGTIME IN CAPE COD May 1-5

DAY 1

Welcome to the sandy shores of Cape Cod. Extending some 70 miles into the sea, the Cape is home to both natural beauty and quaint colonial villages. You can walk pristine beaches, revel in the arts and culture, and reclaim childhood memories of seashells, sandcastles, and saltwater taffy. Lodging for the next four nights is at The Hyannis Harbor Hotel. Dinner is included this evening.

DAY 2

Breakfast is included this morning. Your guide will meet you at your hotel for a full day of touring. You will travel historic Route 6A, the Old King's Highway, a scenic byway winding through centuries of Cape Cod history. It winds past hundreds of historic structures which characterize its early development. View the Eastham Windmill, a Cape Cod Lighthouse and drive through the Cape Cod National Seashore area. Sand dunes and the ocean surround you as you approach "Land's End" – Provincetown. You are now at the extreme tip of Cape Cod. Formerly known as the "Province Lands" the pilgrims landed here first before they decided to settle across the Bay in Plymouth. Take some time to enjoy the wonderful variety of restaurants, shops, and galleries that make this artists/fishermen village so unique. Lunch is on your own today.

This afternoon you may choose to board an excursion vessel for an amazing experience of Whale Watching. You will travel into the natural habitat of a diverse marine environment including birds that migrate here from all over the Atlantic, and fish which use these shallow waters to feed. Try to spot Humpback, Minke, and Fin Whales going about their daily business. An onboard naturalist will introduce you to everything you see and will answer any of your questions about the whales, birds, fish and

lighthouses. For anyone not wishing to go on a whale watch you can enjoy a Dune Tour. Ride along the shoreline of the protected lands of the Cape Cod National Seashore. Your guide will point out the "dune shacks" where famous artists and writers became inspired to create their art. Back on dry land there will be time for shopping and dinner on your own in Provincetown.

DAY 3

Breakfast is included this morning at your hotel. Your guide will meet you at the hotel and travel to the City of Boston. Boston is the city where America's roots were formed and driving through it is like reading the pages of an American history book. Your guide will point out sights along the Freedom Trail as well as the Boston Common and Public Gardens, the Back Bay, Beacon Hill, and the gold-domed State House. You will view the U.S.S. Constitution and see the Bunker Hill Monument. Enjoy free time for lunch and shopping at historic Quincy Market and Faneuil Hall.

This afternoon as you travel back to the Cape a stop will be made in America's Hometown – Plymouth. As one of the country's first settlements it is well known in the United States for its historical value. Picture stops will be made at the Plymouth Rock, the traditional site of disembarkation of the Pilgrims in 1620 and the Mayflower II, a reproduction of the ship that brought the Pilgrims to the New World. Also, a stop will be made at the Forefather's Monument, the largest, solid granite monument in the United States. It stands facing the harbor, welcoming those who come by water. Dinner is included this evening.

DAY 4

Breakfast is included this morning at your hotel. Your guide will meet you at your hotel to conduct a tour of Hyannis including the John F. Kennedy Memorial, the Korean War Memorial, Hyannisport and a view of St. Francis Xavier Church, Kennedy Family Parish. (This is an active house of worship and there will be certain times that we cannot enter the sanctuary.) Included this morning is admission on a Hyannis Harbor Cruise. Aquaint yourself with the area by hopping aboard the historic, old-time Maine coastal steamer, Prudence. Get to know the local landmarks, popular beaches and other points of interest on your way to the historic Kennedy Compound.

You will then travel to Sandwich – the oldest town on Cape Cod. You will have time for lunch on your own. You will then view the Village Green, the Great Salt Marsh, a Cranberry Bog, and Cape Cod Bay. This quaint and quiet seaside community is the hometown of Thornton Burgess, naturalist and author of 170 children's books. Sandwich became the site of one of America's largest glass factories, an industry that flourished during the 19th century.

This afternoon's highlight is admission to the Heritage Museums & Gardens. Heritage offers one hundred acres of trees, shrubs, flowers, and sweeping lawns. Be sure to visit the JK Lilly III Automobile Collection Museum, the American History Museum, and

the Art Museum featuring an operating, hand-carved Carousel made in 1912. Also featured, is the Old East Windmill built in 1800 which was moved from Orleans to Heritage in 1968.

Lobster Dinner is included this evening. An alternate entrée will be available for any "landlubbers" not wishing to eat shellfish.

DAY 5

Breakfast is included this morning at your hotel. You will then depart for home with sand in your shoes, seashells in your pocket and many fond memories of your Catawese Tour to "Olde Cape Cod".
